The Pastor Jots It Down

Our continuing prayers for vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life take on a new meaning this summer as we find seminarians in our midst: Steven Cartwright, our Seminarian intern; and our newly accepted Seminarian Evan Waniewski. I am very proud of Evan Waniewski who received official word from Bishop Burbidge that he has been accepted as a seminary candidate for the Diocese of Raleigh.

Evan first joined a discernment group which meets with the Diocesan Vocation Director every month. In this group the men pray and talk about the priesthood. For the past three months, Evan has been in the application process with Father Ned Shlesinger, Diocesan Vocation Director. Two weeks ago, Evan was invited to the Annual Diocesan Seminarians' Retreat, where he received his letter of acceptance from Bishop Burbidge. Evan who is a 2011 graduate of Craven Community College, now enters into a six/ seven year program of preparation at St. Charles Borromeo Seminary in Philadelphia. He will finish his college education, perhaps a year of pre-theology and then four years of Theology. With Evan's continued prayer and good works, supported by the prayers of our St. Paul Parish Family, he should be ordained a Priest in 2018. I invite all of us to make this prayerful journey with Evan.

Seminarian Steven Cartwright arrived this past Monday for his two month internship at St. Paul Parish. He will be involved in many and varied parish ministries this summer; from assisting at Mass, to visiting the sick and the home-bound, to working with the Summer Bible School, to working with the youth of our parish. He will be introduced to parish boards and committees and in general begin to have a firsthand knowledge of how a parish works.

When we pray for Vocations to Priesthood and Religious Life we need to make these prayers specific, asking the Lord to touch the hearts of men and women in our Parish and in our family. Vocations, like most everything else that is good, begins in the home.

My apologies to Mary Margaret Blout whom I omitted from the Principal Search Committee last week. Mrs. Blout is the third grade teacher and the faculty representative to the School Advisory Committee. She was a very effective member of our Committee and I am grateful for her participation. On Friday evening, June 3, 2011 at the St. Paul Catholic School Graduation Mass, the Joseph Rachid Distinguished Alumni Award was presented to Hannah B. French. She graduated from St. Paul School in 1962. After her graduation from William Gaston Catholic High School in New Bern, she attended the University of Oklahoma where she earned a Bachelor of Arts degree. During her career as a Social Worker she worked with children and families through the Craven County Department of Social Services, retiring after seventeen years as a Supervisor in Child Protective Services. She attributes her choice of career in Social Work to the inspiration of the Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary who taught her at St. Paul. They planted and nurtured the seeds of compassion within her which continues to guide her through life in her devotion to family, as well as her volunteer activities here at St. Paul Parish and in the community. Mrs. French currently serves on the Parish Council and as a Eucharistic Minister, while in the community she volunteers with the Radio Reading Service for the Blind and Visually Impaired. She has always been a strong supporter of Catholic education, giving of her time, talent and treasure. As a parent, she saw her own two children, Meri and Colin graduate from St. Paul Education Center during the 1990's. She is confident that her twelve years of Catholic education gave her an excellent base of knowledge, but in her words, "most importantly...my heart and mind became anchored in Catholicism, and I continue to be sustained by my faith."

This award was initiated in 2006 by the St. Paul School Advisory Board to celebrate the 80th Anniversary of St. Joseph and St. Paul Catholic Schools in New Bern. We were again honored at this 2011 Graduation Mass with the presence of Joyce Rachid and her family, as well as former recipients including Aggie Derda, Margaret Lamb, Tiffany Dove and Deacon Rick Fisher. All were invited to attend the joyful graduation reception which followed Mass. The ongoing goal of this award is to introduce, on an annual basis, positive role models for the school community and to acknowledge their achievements. Such graduates, by their very nature, inspire students to continue to pursue high standards of their own.
