### **The Pastor Jots it Down.**

Last fall we formed the Parish Development Committee with a view to meeting the immediate financial needs of the Parish through the Increased Offertory Campaign. Ever present was the importance of basing this campaign on Stewardship ideals.

We can report that because of your love for the Church, and St. Paul Parish in particular, you have responded most generously. Our offertory and Debt Collection income has increased \$130,000.00 over the same fiscal period of last year, about a 14% increase. We are grateful and we thank you. As we move into the future, we will continue to develop our commitment as stewards of the many gifts God has given us.

We began this fiscal year with a \$200,000.00 deficit and will end the year with a deficit of approximately \$70,000.00. We believe that with careful spending and some cutbacks we will overcome this deficit in this next fiscal year.

I bring all of this to your attention now because we have changed the name of the Development Committee to the Stewardship Committee and added six (6) new members. With advice from Carina Montanari of the Diocesan Stewardship Office, we are developing plans for moving ahead. You will be kept abreast of these actions and plans.

I thank all of you who have donated cars or other vehicles to our Parish. During this fiscal year we have received \$27,000.00 for our debt service. A special thanks to Skip Barnett and Jerry Tetreault who carry out this program.

I am most grateful for your generous gift of \$131,000.00 for St. Paul School toward the requested \$200,000.00 fund for the 2011-2012 school year. God certainly blesses you for this generosity.

I ask you to take a moment this morning to view the model of St. Joseph Church by Richard Elson and Old St. Paul Church by Brooke Diviney displayed in the Atrium. Brooke and Richard are both upcoming 4th grade students at our St. Paul Catholic School.

Her references consistently praised her for her leadership, communication skills, dedication to the mission of her school and the ability to work with students, parents and faculty, as well as the community, to reach important goals and succeed to new heights. She is eager to join our St. Paul Catholic School and parish community as she is in the process of relocating to New Bern at this time.
