I am pleased to announce that Mrs. Marilu Morse of the St. Paul Catholic School faculty has agreed to accept the position of interim Principal of St. Paul School during this transition period. Mrs. Morse, who has held the position of Assistant Principal, has worked closely with Mrs. Mahoney and is well qualified for this responsibility. We ask your prayers for Mrs. Morse in this new role and for all the students, faculty and staff of our wonderful school.

On Saturday, April 2nd, 2011 the Church of Raleigh will go in Pilgrimage to the NATIONAL SHRINE OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION in Washington, D.C. Our Bishop has asked that two promoters of the Pilgrimage be appointed in each parish. If you are interested please call me. I was Diocesan Chairman of this Pilgrimage in 1998 and again in 2008. In 1998 we had about 200 people from the Diocese. In 2008 this number of Faithful from all parts of the Diocese increased to 1500. It is a wonderful day of prayer and of rejoicing in the Love of God for our Country and for each of us. It is a wonderful day to honor our Blessed Mother, Mary, who is our constant intercessor with her Son in Heaven. I urge you to give prayerful thought to this Pilgrimage in April. Plans for the Pilgrimage will be communicated to you as they become available.

Another more urgent request from our Bishop is that we join in a novena of prayer for our Diocesan Seminarian Philip Johnson. Philip, a student at St. Charles Borromeo Seminary, continues to live with a brain tumor that continues to progress in spite of several treatments. The Novena will begin on November 29 and will continue to the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, December 8.

I praise God for you and thank you for all that you have done and are doing for our St. Paul Parish.

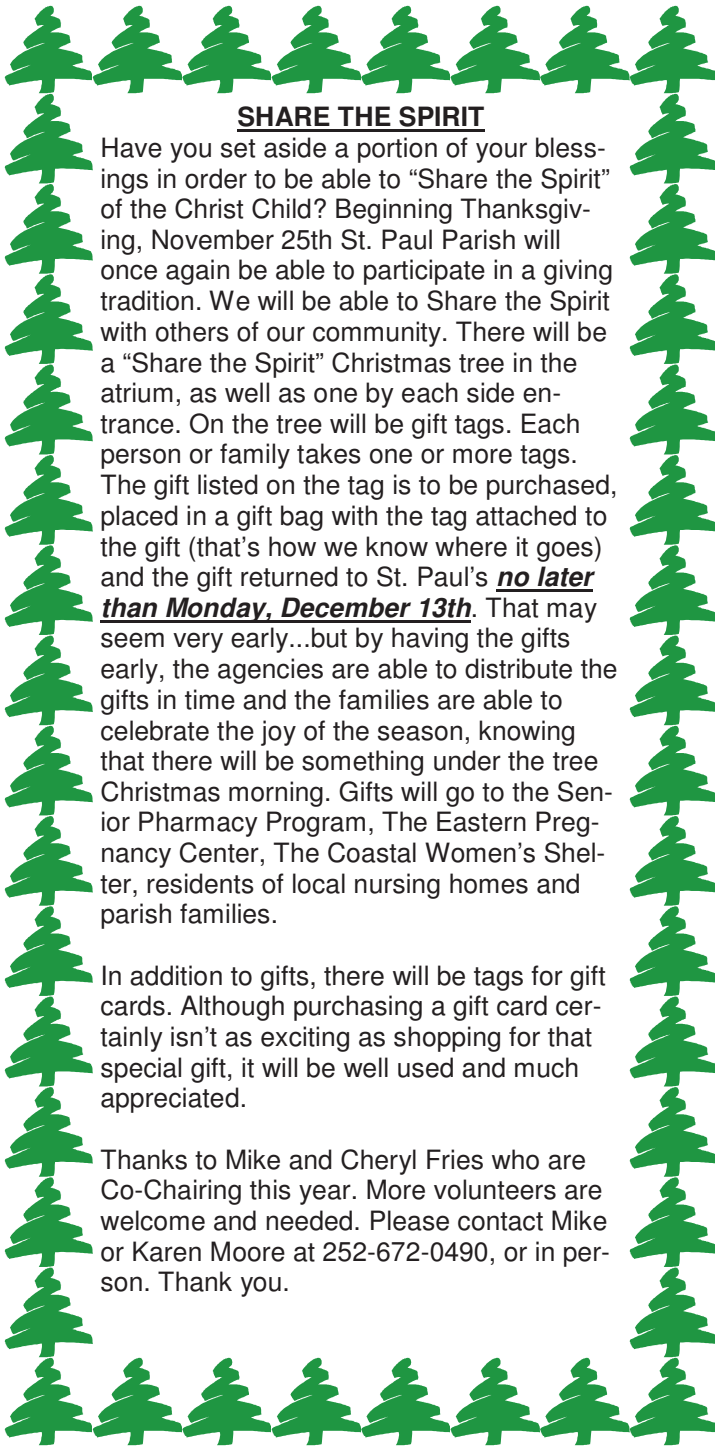
