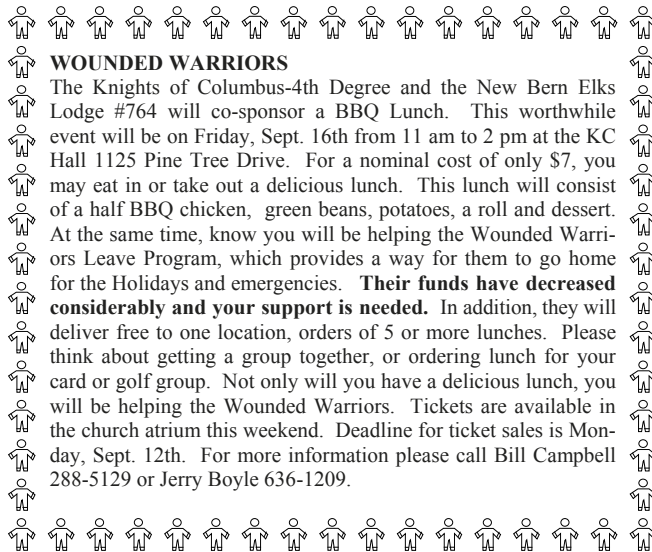
In lieu of a dish, Catholic Daughters of the Americas are asked to bring tea and lemonade.
